Administrative:

- Our 2018-'19 Board meetings are on the last Wednesday of each month at 3:00 p.m. at the station. Remaining dates are April 24, May 29 and June 26.

Budget/Fundraising:

- LRPA's 2019 basic cable subscriber numbers break down as follows:
 - Belmont: 1,505 (up 174 subscribers from 2018)
 - o Gilford 2,642 (up 312 subscribers from 2018)

 Meredith: 4,854 (up 676 subscribers from 2018)
 - 2,267 (up 376 subscribers from 2018)
